

Masonic Instructors Examination with Time

The requirements for Masonic Instructors are as follows:

1. Open a Lodge of Entered Apprentices.
2. Close a Lodge of Entered Apprentices.
3. Call from labor to refreshment (with and without time).
4. Call from refreshment to labor (on higher degree and resume labor).
6. Constitutional Questions.
5. Confer First Section, First Degree.
6. First Degree Explanatory Lecture.

This constitutes the requirement of the First Degree and may be taken in one day at Regional Schools or at Grand Lodge or by special arrangement.

8. Confer First Section, Second Degree.
9. Confer Ritual of Second Section, Second Degree.

This constitutes the requirement of the Second Degree and must be taken within nine months of taking the First Degree requirements.

11. Confer First Section, Third Degree.
12. Confer Second Section, Third Degree. (Specifying speaker)

This constitutes the requirement of the Third Degree and must be taken within nine months of taking the Second Section requirements. This completes the requirements for a Masonic Instructor's Certificate and if successfully completed such will be granted.

The three years as a Masonic Instructor shall not be waived since it is the opportunity to learn and polish the floor movements corresponding to the Ritual (Webb Work). These will be monitored by the Board of Custodians and if satisfactory will constitute the requirements for a District Lecturer's Certificate.
